Subject: Chesterton Academy Establishes Dual Enrollment with Prestigious Catholic University

High school students at all 50 Chesterton Academies around the world will now have the opportunity to earn college credit while completing their normal coursework during high school.

Earlier this month Dale Ahlquist, President of the Society of G.K. Chesterton and founding member of the Chesterton Schools Network (CSN), and Fr. Dave Pivonka, President of Franciscan University of Steubenville (FUS), entered into a historic partnership that will allow students at Chesterton Academies to concurrently enroll at FUS and receive college credit upon successful completion of FUS courses.

"This partnership will be of great benefit to both the University and the Chesterton Schools Network," said Dale Ahlquist, President of the Chesterton Society. "There is great excitement all around."

This fall, junior and senior students will be eligible to enroll in twelve credit hours of courses similar to the CSN theology and philosophy classes. Dual enrollment opportunities will eventually grow to 36 credit hours.

The Chesterton Academy student experience will not change as enrollment with FUS is remote and requires only a supplemental college-level assessment to pass the course. Successful completion of this requirement will result in an official transcript from FUS.

Although there is a cost per course, it is an extremely affordable option for high school students desiring to earn college credits.

The program begins this fall, 2022.

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
